In the summer of 2009, Steven “Boots” Powless from nearby Six Nations began a 6 month occupation of the front lawn of 75 year old Ernie Palmer who lives alone on the outskirts of Caledonia.

The media said that Mr. Palmer was “in on” the occupation and some suggested he had invited Powless to set up an illegal smoke shack on his property.

In October of 2010, I was contacted by Mr. Palmer who wanted to set the record straight. I sat down with him for an interview that lasted over 90 minutes, and heard a horrifying story that no media had attempted to tell.

His story represents a unique chapter in Canadian history and I’m honoured to have been chosen by Mr. Palmer to share it.
